RISK MANAGEMENT (continued)	
AgriStability Late Fee	• The deadline to file completed program forms and required documents to the Administration is September 30 of the year following the Program Year. If the participant provides the completed program forms and required documents after the deadline, but within three months of the deadline, the Administration will deduct \$500 per month (or part thereof) which passed since the deadline. If the reduction is greater than the amount otherwise payable, the amount payable shall be reduced to zero, and the remainder of the reduction shall not be applied to any other program year. If a participant fails to provide the required forms and documentation within three months after the deadline, then the participant shall not be eligible for a payment for that program year.
Authority to Waive Fees: Unless otherwise indicated herein, Risk Management fees can be reduced, waived and refunded by the Chief Executive Officer or delegate where AFSC considers the circumstances warrant such action.
