Pursuant to Section 11 of the *Agriculture Financial Services Act*

All Direct Loans and Specific Guarantees	
Loan Fee (Applies for new loan approvals).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 0.5% of the loan/guarantee amount up to and including \$2 million; and 0.25% thereafter (minimum \$250)
Rush or Direct Deposit Disbursement Fee (Non-EFT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$50 for each request
Renewal Fee (Applies only upon renewal at term maturity)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 0.25% of the renewed loan/guarantee amount up to and including \$2 million; and 0.125% thereafter (minimum \$250)
Loan Guarantee Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3% of the guarantee amount per annum (minimum \$500) • (For a Specific Guarantee issued for a period of less than one-year the fee will be prorated subject to a minimum of 3 months)
Specific Loan Guarantee Program for Feeder Associations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1.10% of the guarantee amount per annum
Security Fee (When security prepared internally)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$150 – Security Agreement, Security Agreement Amending Agreement, Loan Guarantee, Loan Guarantee Amendment (Renewal) and Mortgage Amending Agreement. (No fee will apply for Loan Offer Letter, Promissory Note and Indemnification Agreements) Multiple documents prepared concurrently will only be assessed a single fee.
Amendment Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$150 charged for the first amendment. No additional fee will be assessed for amendments which occur concurrently. No fee needs to be assessed for AFSC initiated or Administrative Change amendments.
Capital Sourcing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Capital Sourcing Fees are negotiated between AFSC and the client based on the complexity of the work required to assist the client, and are subject to the approval of the Chief Executive Officer or delegate. The minimum fee charged will be 0.125% of the debt capital sourced or \$500, whichever is greater.
Administration and other Fees (including disbursement, standby/commitment and inspection fees)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fees are negotiated between AFSC and the client based on complexity of the requirement and subject to the approval of the Team Coordinator.
Property Insurance Administration Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A fee equal to 20 percent of premiums or \$2,500, whichever is less
Loan Decline Review	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$300 - If the appeal is successful this fee will be refunded.
Authority to Adjust Lending Fees: Unless otherwise indicated herein, any of the above Lending fees can be waived, amended or increased by the Chief Executive Officer or delegate where AFSC considers the circumstances warrant such action.

Finance Administration Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A fee of \$45 will be charged for all items returned by Financial Institutions where the client is at fault. If the request is initiated by AFSC, no fee will be charged.
Authority to Waive Fees: Unless otherwise indicated herein, Finance fees can be reduced, waived and refunded by the Chief Executive Officer or delegate where AFSC considers the circumstances warrant such action.

AgrilInsurance Administration Fee <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fees for PreHarvest Re-inspections for additional crop damage occurring after initial inspection but before put to another use – subject to cause of delay 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$80 per hour for each inspector plus government rate per kilometer plus the cost of equipment use (e.g. drone) to a maximum of \$500 per day.

AgriStability Producer Contribution Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An annual fee based on the Producers Contribution Reference Margin, multiplied by 0.45 percent, multiplied by 70 percent. The minimum fee charged is \$45. The initial deadline to pay the fee is the later of 30 days after issuance of the Enrolment/Fee Notice or April 30 of the Program Year. If payment is not received by the deadline, an additional 20 per cent will be added to the fee. If the original amount of the Producer Contribution Fee is not received by December 31 of the Program Year or 60 days after the Enrolment Notice is issued, whichever is later, the participant shall be ineligible for payments for that program year.
AgriStability Administrative Cost Sharing (ACS) Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$55 fee per participant for each Program Year that the participant is enrolled in the program

RISK MANAGEMENT (continued)

AgriStability Late Fee

- The deadline to file completed program forms and required documents to the Administration is September 30 of the year following the Program Year. If the participant provides the completed program forms and required documents after the deadline, but within three months of the deadline, the Administration will deduct \$500 per month (or part thereof) which passed since the deadline. If the reduction is greater than the amount otherwise payable, the amount payable shall be reduced to zero, and the remainder of the reduction shall not be applied to any other program year. If a participant fails to provide the required forms and documentation within three months after the deadline, then the participant shall not be eligible for a payment for that program year.

Authority to Waive Fees: Unless otherwise indicated herein, Risk Management fees can be reduced, waived and refunded by the Chief Executive Officer or delegate where AFSC considers the circumstances warrant such action.
